## About the Venue

We are in a National Park, surrounded by Sea and the Lagoon - PLEASE NOTE there is Little to No reception for mobile devices. There is a 5-minute drive to shops and reception. The beach and lagoon are unmanned, therefore, please take care when entering the water.

The carpark is level and can be used for small campervans (not caravans), but there is a limited space, so please let us know ahead of time so we can mark off an area for you to park. The Gates to the Camp will be closed at 10pm to 4am daily.

The buildings are all ground floor. There are some steps. The only flight of stairs are to the lower grassed areas and the camping area.

We have a main dining hall and we will ask that you all take turns in the clean up of room, tables and chairs for meals. There is a separate kitchen for 'selfcaterers'.

Market Stalls will be in the sunroom between the Hall and Dining Room (a site map is provided in this pack).

The main hall is a beautiful wood floor room with views out over the grass and lagoon. It has ground level entry, and has a balcony looking out over the grass.




